

AUDITING

Environmental Audits are tools used to assess an organisation's environmental performance, position and regulatory compliance. Integrate Sustainability can provide a range of services to assist you in managing your audit requirements. This includes 3rd party audits, audits for Approvals, or audits of Environmental Management Systems and Plans.

- Due Diligence Audits to determine environmental risk and any potential liability associated with a proposal, property divestment/investment or merger
- Environmental Management Audits to determine the effectiveness of business planning, management systems, resources and personnel in managing the environmental impact of a company's operations
- Combined Audits where a company has particular objectives then a combination of the above audits can be carried out. Action plans can be developed to identify environmental remedial actions required and prioritise these based on criteria developed with the company
- Compliance Audits to determine compliance with environmental licenses, approvals, regulatory requirements, industry codes of practice, company guidelines and environmental policies
- Environmental Performance Audits facilities and processes audit to determine efficiency opportunities such as reducing energy usage, reducing waste production, air emissions and optimising resource usage.
- Environmental Management System (EMS) Audits our Environmental auditors are trained to meet the qualification criteria as described in ISO 19011: 2011 Guidelines for Auditing Management Systems, with the aim of determining performance against the Corporate EMS
