

MRF REPORTING

Mining Operators in Western Australia are required to record and submit their disturbance data and money annually as part of the Mine Rehabilitation Fund (MRF). Contributions to the pooled are based on the level of ground disturbance for mining tenements granted under the *Mining Act 1978 (WA)*. The fund is used by the State to rehabilitate historical abandoned mines.
